- an introduction to Melbourne's world class Universities.

This is a fully escorted program which is aimed at those students looking to study abroad in the future.

Who is the Australian Camps Association?

The Australian Camps Association (ACA) is a national organisation that represents 130 camps in Victoria. Our work aims to provide unforgettable camp experiences with outdoor activities for groups of children and adults.

What does an ACA member camp look like?

- Introduction and visits to local universities in Victoria (both inner city and regional).
- Cultural engagement and learning sessions with Indigenous Australians.
- Learning about Australian natural history and animals (such as koalas, kangaroos and platypus) at Healesville Sanctuary and Melbourne Zoo.
- Visiting historical venues such as the acclaimed Sovereign Hill in the gold rush village at Ballarat.
